

REPRIEVE

Pursuant to the authority vested in me by Article III, Section 6 of the Constitution of the State of Tennessee, I, Bill Lee, Governor of the State of Tennessee, do hereby grant to Urshawn Eric Miller a reprieve from execution of the sentence of death imposed upon him by the Criminal Court for Madison County in 2018 and scheduled to be carried out on October 17, 2022. *State v. Miller*, No. W2019-00197-SC-DDT-DD (Tenn. Dec. 7, 2021). This reprieve shall continue in effect until December 31, 2022.
