ORDER SETTING EXECUTION DATE

The Court has reviewed the State's email to Judicial Staff Counsel advising the Court that all direct appeal, state habeas proceedings, and federal habeas proceedings have concluded and it is an appropriate time to set an execution date in the above styled and numbered cause; and whereas

The Defendant, Wesley Ruiz, was previously sentenced to death by the Court in the presence of his attorneys;

The Court therefore, now enters the following **ORDER**:

IT IS HEREBY ORDERED that the Defendant, Wesley Ruiz, who has been adjudged to be guilty of capital murder as charged in the indictment and whose punishment has been assessed by the verdict of the jury and judgment of the Court at death, shall be kept in custody by the Director of the Texas Department of Criminal Justice, Institutional Division, until the **1st day of February, 2023**, upon which day, at the Texas Department of Criminal Justice, Institutional Division, at some time after the hour of six o'clock p.m., in a room arranged for the purpose of execution, the said Director, acting by and through the executioner designated by said Director, as provided by law, is hereby commanded, ordered and directed


to carry out this sentence of death by intravenous injection of a substance or substances in a lethal quantity sufficient to cause the death of the said Wesley Ruiz until the said Wesley Ruiz is dead. Such procedure shall be determined and supervised by the said Director of the Texas Department of Criminal Justice, Institutional Division.

Within 10 days of the signing of this Order, the Clerk of this Court shall issue and deliver to the Sheriff of Dallas County, Texas, a Warrant of Execution in accordance with this Order, directed to the Director of the Texas Department of Criminal Justice, Institutional Division, at Huntsville, Texas, commanding him, the said Director, to put into execution the judgment of death against the said Wesley Ruiz.

The Sheriff of Dallas County, Texas is hereby ordered, upon receipt of said Warrant of Execution, to deliver said Warrant to the Director of the Department of Criminal Justice, Institutional Division, Huntsville, Texas.

The Clerk of this Court is ordered to forward a copy of this Order to Defendant's counsel, Shawn Nolan, Shawn_Nolan@fd.org and Peter Walker, Peter_Walker@fd.org, to counsel for the State, Anna Kubalak Anna.Kubalak@dallascounty.org, and to the Director of the Office of Capital and Forensic Writs, Benjamin Wolff, Benjamin.Wolff@ocfw.texas.gov within three days of receipt of this Order.


